

Zone 5 Game Cancellation Policy

Following approval of a final zone game schedule by the Zone Scheduler and Zone Director it is deemed official.

At this time the following regulations are in place:

- If a final zone game schedule has been set, a \$200 fine will be applied to each Rep team that requests to cancel an already scheduled game.
 - Cancellations, or rescheduling requests, within 24 hrs of game time will result in a fine of \$250. \$50 will go to the Zone, \$200 will be reimbursed by the Zone Council to the club that was cancelled on and incurred expenses as a result of the cancellation or rescheduling.
- The team is able to appeal this fine to the Zone Council.

Zone 5 No Show Policy

A club (team) who does not show up for a scheduled zone game will be fined \$500 per game.

Rescheduling Games

When a game is rescheduled, the new mutually agreed upon date, time and location must be communicated to the Zone scheduler within 48 hrs of the rescheduling request. If a game is not mutually agreed upon it will fall under the Game cancellation policy.

If a game is rescheduled with a minimum of 14 days notice, where both clubs mutually agree to the rescheduled time, date and location prior to Zone playoffs, no fine will be issued.

If a game is rescheduled with a minimum of 7 days notice, where both clubs mutually agree to the rescheduled time, date and location prior to Zone playoffs, a fine of \$100 will be issued.

- When the visiting team initiates the rescheduling, the home team will be reimbursed \$100 from the Zone Council.

If a game is rescheduled with less than 7 days notice, but more than 24 hrs notice, and both clubs mutually agree to the rescheduled time, date and location prior to Zone playoffs, a fine of \$150 will be issued.

- When the visiting team initiates the rescheduling, the home team will be reimbursed \$100 from the Zone Council.

Note: Game time changes (example 2:00pm changed to 4:00 pm) which are mutually agreed upon will not result in a fine.

All game changes, additions and cancellations are to be communicated to both the Zone RIC and the Zone Scheduler. Failure to communicate any changes or cancellations results in a \$50 fine plus additional fines as outlined.
